


- 1. Clean out the pumpkin, scraping the flesh thinnest in the region in which you'll carve the design. Use a photo copier to enlarge or reduce the pattern to fit the pumpkin.
- 2. Attach the pattern to the pumpkin with tape.
- 3. Use a pin to make closely spaced pin pricks along the stencil lines, piercing the paper.
- 4. Use pumpkin carving tools to cut out the black areas of the pattern.
